1. Type of Event, Location and Facilities

These Terms and conditions are valid for each attendee registering for the 2020 Outpost Writing Workshop.

Outpost is held at the Nature Conservancy's Zumwalt Prairie Preserve in Wallowa County. This is an outdoor setting with inherent risks, hazards, and dangers. All registrants agree to follow the rules and policies at these venues. No pets are allowed at either location.

2. Registration and Payment

3. Fishtrap's Outpost Writing Workshop Cancellation and Refund Policy:

If, for any reason, you need to cancel your plans to attend Summer Fishtrap or Outpost, our refund policy is as follows:

Fishtrap registration includes a \$100 nonrefundable deposit as part of the total fee. Registrants cancelling Outpost registration by May 1, 2020 will be issued a full refund minus the deposit. Registrants cancelling registration from May 2-May 31, 2020 will be issued 50% refund of the total registration fee minus the deposit. No refunds will be issued after June 1, 2020.

In the unlikely event that Outpost is cancelled, all registrants will have the option of receiving a full refund, including deposit, or receiving registration credit for the following year's Summer Fishtrap Gathering or Outpost event. Fishtrap is not responsible for any travel costs.
