Who can apply?

Applicants will be considered based on financial need, age, and a personal letter describing how Summer Fishtrap can enrich your writing. **Applications are accepted from now through April 31, 2020.**

How to Apply for a Summer Fishtrap Youth Scholarship

- Ages 10-13: Please send a brief letter stating your desire to attend Summer Fishtrap, and why you look forward to attending Cameron Scott's "Lightbringers, iPads, Mufflewumps, Oh My!"
- Ages 14-18: Please send a brief letter stating your desire to attend Summer Fishtrap, and why you look forward to attending MOsley WOtta's "Stitching Chaos." In addition to your letter, please include a typed writing sample 3-5 pages in length.

All application letters must include youth applicant's name, parent or guardian name, email, and phone contact information.
